More than 90% of the time this brings a Radio back to its original or better operating condition. There are two ways I calculate a price for a n antique Radio restoration. One way is \$10.00 (150 volt radios) or \$15.00 (higher voltage radios) per capacitor + other parts. If it's going to cost more than \$20.00 per capacitor with all the extra parts, I make \$20.00 per capacitor a flat rate price, which includes almost anything and everything necessary to get your antique Radio working like new or better. I call this my White Glove Service. Minimum cost of all tube type Radio restorations is \$75.00. Signing this form and sending a Money Order tells me that you are serious about having your Antique Radio(s) restored.

Normally the turn around time to restore an antique Radio is 2-3 days. Occasionally there are "complications" and the Radio needs parts beyond the paper and electrolytic capacitors, and dial lamp(s), if any. This might make your set take longer to restore. Most of the time, though, after replacing all paper and electrolytic capacitors, and making a few minor adjustments, an antique Radio will operate like new or better.
